### Helpful tips & information about visiting a veterinarian:

- If the veterinarian has not previously seen/treated your pet, bringing your pet's most current vaccine and applicable medical records is very helpful, and could help you avoid duplicate fees for diagnostics or treatment.
- With your first visit, be prepared to pay for initial costs which generally include the office visit/exam, plus basic diagnostics such as bloodwork, urinalysis, and/or x-rays. For most ailments, at a minimum bloodwork will be needed to get a baseline of the pet's general health status, which will help guide your pet's treatment.
- Be prepared to give your veterinarian dates/timeframes of symptom activity, and the what/when of any medicines or supplements you may have given your pet.
- Make a list in advance of questions you may have for your veterinarian. This will save time and help ensure you leave with a good understanding of your pet's condition. Don't be afraid to ask questions!
- We all want the best for our pets, but when finances are strained, we may need to focus only on the immediate needs. When presented with an estimate of costs, ask if there are any services that are not crucial at that time, and about the most conservative care options.
